**Preparation:** The walk will be around the streets, alleyways and foreshore of Robin Hoods Bay with the opportunity to purchase food and drinks at several locations.

The walk has been timed to coincide with the Robin Hoods Bay Victorian Weekend. This is an annual event where visitors and residents are invited to dress up in traditional Victorian Costume. There will be Christmas Decorations and music everywhere you go, in the streets, in the pubs, shops & café's and inside the churches too. There will be arts and crafts, carollers, hand-bell ringers, lucky dips, tombolas, spinning demonstrations, ganseys, mince pies and lots of other surprises awaiting you.

For lunch if you decide to eat out, there are many pubs and cafes scattered about Robin Hoods Bay.
